

STARs with Route Type 3 segments New idents for converted procedures from cycle 1102 on

Dear valued customer,

At some airports there exists Standard Terminal Arrival Routes (STARs) with one single ident but multiple runway transitions (Route Type 3). Some FMS are limited in regards to Route Type 3 STARs.

To our current knowledge the following FMS are affected:

Aircraft type	FMS memory/type
Airbus A300/310	191k, 512k
Airbus A318/319/320/321	191k, 400k
Airbus A330/340	1-Meg Legacy
Boeing B747	1-Meg
Boeing B757/767	200k, 1-Meg
MDD/Boeing MD-8x	200k, 650k
MDD/Boeing MD-11	1-Meg Legacy
Fokker F70/100	191k, 512k

To support our customer with those FMS, we offer to generate conversions of the affected STARs and code them in a different way so also the **non**-Route Type 3 STAR capable FMS do have these STARs available. We code the entire STAR separately for each runway with a runway-specific STAR ident. On customer request, we add these converted STARs to the desired Navdatabase(s) and for the requested airports.

Starting cycle 1102, the procedure idents of converted STARs will change, improving transparency and enhancing identification of the procedure.

In Appendix A you will find the new general rule with examples of the new converted STAR idents as of cycle 1102.
